


Noughts and Crosses

Instructions

These instructions should accompany the OCR generic resource 'Noughts and Crosses'

Expected Duration:

Approx. 10 minutes

Noughts and Crosses is a classroom quiz resource based on the classic game. Teams compete to answer questions and complete a row of three symbols.

Preparation:

Noughts and Crosses is a generic resource that can be used with any subject and topic. Questions and answers need to be prepared in advance and recorded on a separate sheet.

The Activity:

Divide the group in two teams – the noughts and the crosses.

Each team takes turns to answer questions. If they get the question right they can nominate a square to change to their symbol.

The winning team is the first to get three symbols in a row.

To play again click the 'Reset Grid' button.
